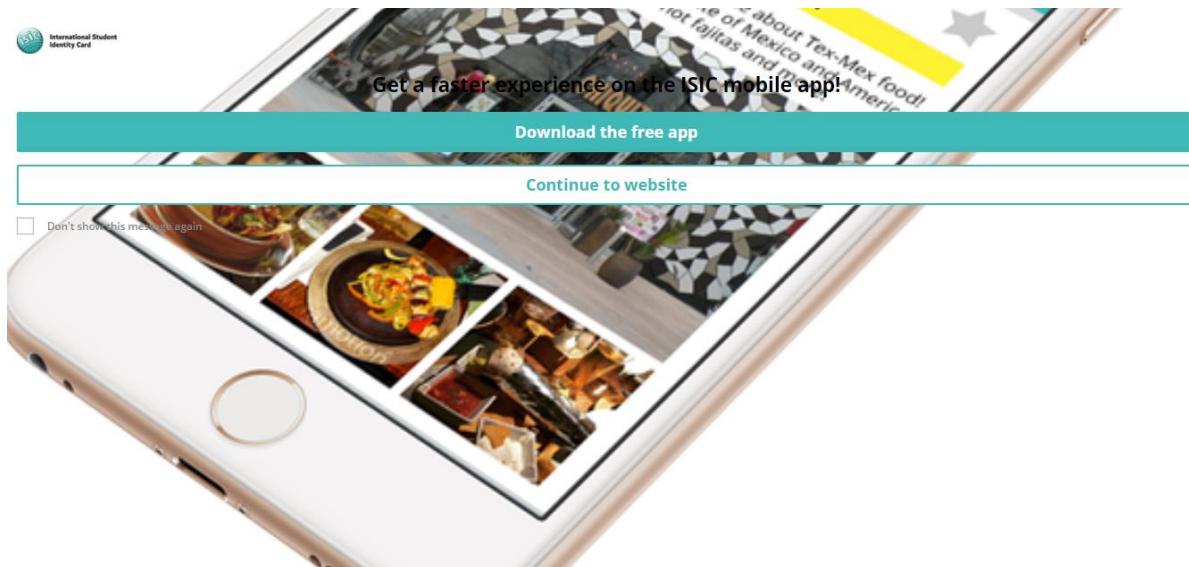


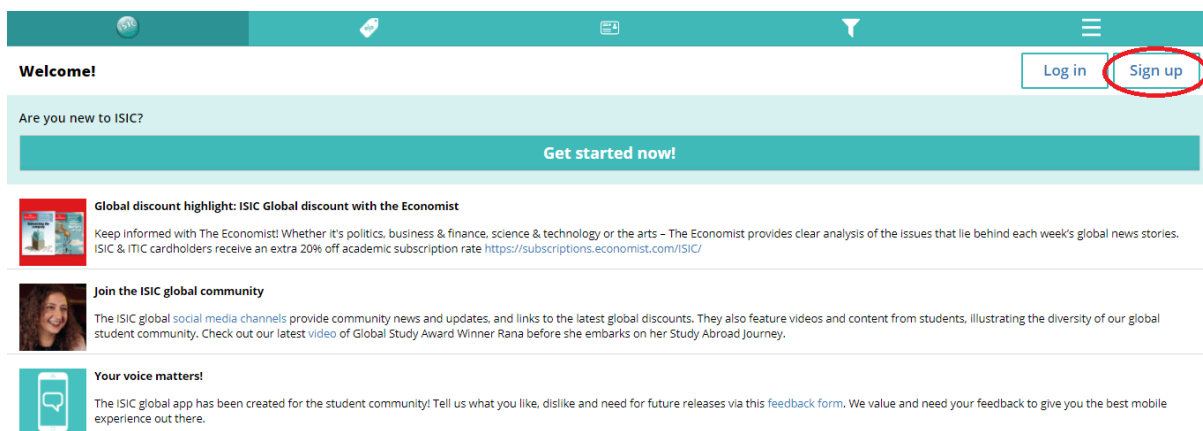
Accessing your virtual card without using your smart phone

To access your ISIC Virtual ID on desktops, please follow the steps below:

1. Go to <https://m.isic.org>.
2. Choose: Continue to website.




3. To create an account click *Sign up*.



4. Enter your name as it is written on your card and your 14-digit ISIC number (for example S 123 456 789 012 X). Check if your card is valid.

8. To access your ISIC Virtual ID, click the icon marked in red below.



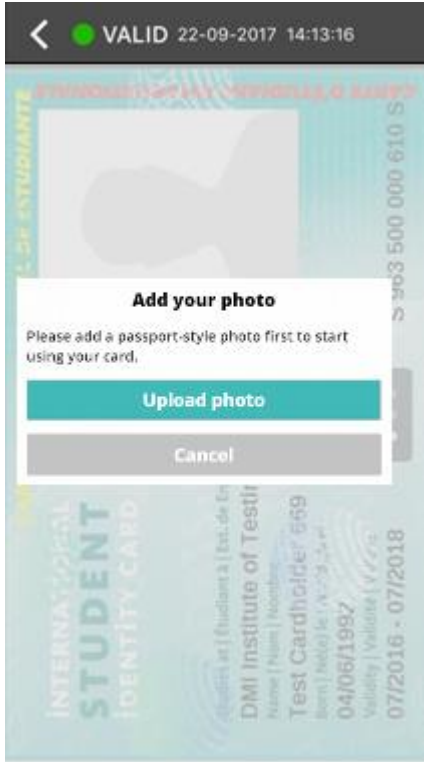
9. Enter your password
